City's Tourist Information Centre to Return Following Lib Dem Action

A tourist information centre (TIC) for Norwich could be up and running ready for summer visitors following a successful Liberal Democrat budget amendment at city hall.

Lib Dem leader in Norwich, Cllr James Wright, who spearheaded the proposal said, "There is a commitment to finance an options appraisal followed by up to £100,000 to deliver, with partners, a TIC somewhere in the city – it could operate from a market stall, City Hall, or another suitable venue."

Tourism is one of Norfolk's largest economic sectors and set to grow by 3.8% in the coming year. We cannot afford to miss out on this opportunity to promote the city's wealth of leisure, culture, and heritage opportunities. **This is an investment in the future of our city, creating many more jobs.**

The previous TIC in the Forum closed in April 2021. It has been a long term aim of the Norwich Liberal Democrats to see the re-opening of a TIC for Norwich.

Speeding on St Mildreds Rd
After contact from local residents, the Lib Dems put out a survey asking for views on speeding.

Uneven Slabs
We have been reporting uneven and dangerous paving slabs on the Avenues.

UEA Night Bus
Lib Dems have been pushing for a night-time blue bus service between the UEA and city, to keep students safe and our streets quiet at night. Our motion to the city council got unanimous approval.

Alleyway Cut-Throughs
Local residents told us about crime in the alleyways into the Salter Avenue area. We reported this to the police at our regular meeting.

Cleaning Up Public Paths
Having been neglected by the council for years, Lib Dem activists got their hands dirty to clean up North Park Avenue.

Nuisance Parking & Grass Verge Damage
We agree with local residents that additional parking measures need to be considered to prevent verge chewing on George Borrow Rd.

Nuisance Parking on Christchurch Rd
We canvassed in October for views on nuisance parking, and support longer double-yellow lines from Earlham Road. Timed parking restrictions should also be considered along the road.

Empty House
We investigated an empty council property on Harbord Rd.

Overflowing Drain
We have consistently been reporting the drain at the entrance to Eaton Park from NPA.
